I hereby grant the U. S. Forest Service permission to continue having Forest Service locks (interchangeable) with our locks) on the two road gates in Sec. 2, T4N, R12E.

I hereby agree to have the U. S. Forest Service build a facility on our property (Section 2, T4N, R12E) to allow the passage of pack stock and back-packers. This facility will be placed within twenty (20) feet of the interchangeable locked road gate.

I hereby agree to have the U. S. Forest Service build a unloading facility conveniently located in relation to the pack stock gate on our property (Section 2, T4N, R12E). The exact location will be mutually agreed to on-the-ground.


The Forest Service agrees to build and place the following sign:

No Motorized Vehicles

This sign will be placed so it is easily visible when people are facing the pack stock and backpacker gate in Section 2, T4N, R12E.

To avoid further private property damage and theft, the Forest Service agrees to have the pack stock and backpacker gate locked after the field season. This would mean the pack stock and backpacker gate would be locked after the last day of hunting season and opened June 1st each year.
